DIGI-CIVIS MEETING IN MONS: PROGRESS AND FUTURE STEPS

The Digi-Civis team gathered in Mons on the 11th and 12th July to discuss the project's progress and plan the next steps. The E-learning platform was directly tested by schools to identify any improvements that could enhance its usability for students.

A significant focus was placed on the development of the Pedagogical Sequences, ensuring alignment with the project's objectives. Another key point was the introduction of the "Reality Task Toolkit", which will include situational cards, role-playing activities, and flashcards.

Sustainability was also given considerable attention: partners agreed to measure the environmental impact of their actions, even within individual institutions. As part of this, a questionnaire on ecological practices will be circulated every six months.

We concluded the meeting with discussions about external communication strategies, particularly using social media, the project website and the e-Twinning platform to further promote the circulation of project outcomes and foster digital education across Europe.

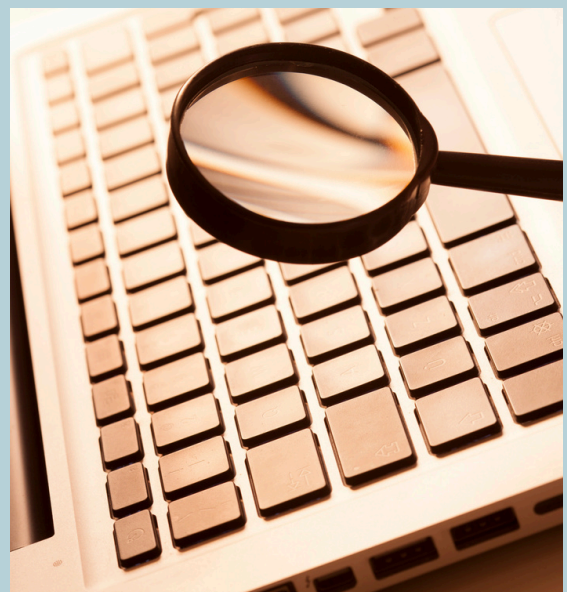
